CHILDREN & FAMILIES WORK

We have been very blessed to be able to employ since August 2014 a very talented full time Children & Families Worker, Peter Shields. Peter would like to explore the scope for reducing his role with us from 40 hours per week to 20 hours per week, with the balance made up from either another part time member of staff, or volunteers, or a combination. The two PCCs (church councils) will be reviewing the options around this at their February Combined PCC meeting. In the meantime, Peter will be trialling his reduced hours alongside work as a delivery driver for Sainsburys. Please pray for Peter and the PCCs, that we may have wisdom in our discussions. Our churches have formed a partnership with three Didcot churches - King's Church.
Ridgeway Church and Didcot Baptist Church - to set up a Christians Against Poverty (CAP) Debt Centre serving those in Didcot and the surrounding area.

To mark the launch of this exciting outreach partnership, there is special combined service at St Birinus School Didcot from 10.30am next Sunday, 15th January, including a programme for children and youth. Coffee and pastries from 10.10am! Please come to this service if you can, but for those who are unable or would rather not, there will still be services at All Saints' and at St Matthew's at the regular times.

JOB VACANCY

Debt Coach for Didcot (part-time)

Do you have a heart for evangelism in our local community, working with poor or disadvantaged people?

If so, please prayerfully consider whether God is calling you to join the local CAP (Christians Against Poverty) Debt Centre as a part-time Debt Coach.

The post, which will operate predominantly in the Didcot area, is for 8 hours a week for one year initially with the possibility of extension beyond that. Salary: £20k per annum pro rata (£4,267 per annum).
