MEN IN SUDAN



Reverend Hassan Abduraheem, Mr Petr Jašek and Mr Abdumonem Abdumawla have been found guilty of a number of charges, including espionage, a national security crime. Czech national Mr Jašek was found guilty of espionage and sentenced to life imprisonment. Reverend Abduraheem and Mr Abdumawla were found guilty of espionage and abatement and sentenced to ten years imprisonment. The pastors' lawyers intend to launch an appeal.
